SANOOK, MEANING “FUN” in Thai, is a guiding principle of Asian social life. “Sanook” therefore is the perfect name for this funky Bistro and Sports Bar right next to a lake which not only looks good, the breezes from the lake are like an al fresco air-con!

Sanook is dedicated to serving fresh, nutritious food at very reasonable prices, hand picked from the best of Asian, European, Antipodean and US cuisine. The “Chief Food Artist” (CFA) is Benhar Amirul and he is passionate about his art. During a delightful evening that my wife, Gudrun, and I spent at Sanook recently, the CFA and the Chief People Pleaser (CPP – Maitre De), Che Mat and the owner, “Godfather Yow”, looked after us regally.

We started our meal with “Bruschetta De Gambas” consisting of prawns, calamari, mussels, mozzarella and tomatoes on toast...delicious! This was followed by “Walking Snail Escargots” sauted in garlic butter served with toasted foccacia bread....awesome! Baked Oysters with crème mushroom ragout and mozzarella, chased by a sensational Barramundi “Bara Bara” pizza direct from the in-house wood fired pizza oven. These selections were washed down with some epic Australian red wines served in classy red wine glasses do these excellent wines justice. We then enjoyed an extremely tender lamb shank cooked over a slow fire served with rosemary herbs, baby kai-lan and mashed potatoes. An amazing Tiramisu finished off an extraordinary meal.

Even more amazing is that one can dine “al fresco” sitting beside the lake or in air-conditioned comfort in-doors. Upstairs is the Sport Bar with a pool table and cosy bar seating and outside there is a terrace that can cater for several hundred guests.

With a truly international menu, a sensational selection of beverages and a wonderful ambience to suit any mood or occasion, Sanook is a Bistro and Sports Bar that should be on everyone’s list of “in” places. We loved it! **By David Bradley**
